We were recently visited by the CCS monitor to carry out an audit and assessment of the project. The audit considers five areas of assessment and provides feedback and a score rating for each area. Work carried out in January 2020

A46 Eastbound exit slip

- Completion of drainage
- Completion of new ducting
- Completion of kerbing
- Surfacing to new widening
- Raise levels in farmer's field

Leicester Road

- Surfacing to new widening and footpath

A46 Westbound entry slip/Gynsill Lane

- Completion of drainage
- Completion of ducting
- Completion of kerbing on slip road
- Completion of road widening including surfacing

Anstey Lane

- New dual carriageway kerbing
- New carriageway construction completion

Bennion Road Roundabout

- West corner road construction and concrete base
- East corner ducting within new footpath and verge for street lighting and traffic signals and edgings to new footpath



February 2020 planned works summary

A46 Westbound entry slip/Gynsill Lane

- Completion of ducting
- Completion of kerbing on Gynsill Lane

A46 Roundabout

- Installation of street lighting columns and cabling for junction
- Installation of signposts for junction (plus some signs if possible)
- Completion of Anstey Lane entry splitter island Kerbing, Ducting and new construction.

Anstey Lane

- New dual carriageway kerbing
- New carriageway construction completion

February road closure details

Night shift road closures (between 20:00 & 06:00) (Sunday to Thursday only)

A46 Eastbound exit slip, from 7th January to 28th February, and 8th March to 14th March – Diversion route to continue to A6 Roundabout and return on A46 Westbound back to Anstey Lane junction.

A46 Westbound exit slip, from 1st March to 5th March – Diversion route to continue to A50 Roundabout and return on A46 Westbound back to Anstey Lane junction.

A46 Westbound entry slip, from 23rd February to 9th March – Diversion route take A46 to A6 Roundabout and return on A46 Westbound back to Anstey Lane junction.

Anstey Lane, Gorse Hill to Bennion Road, from 23rd February to 26th February – Diversion route outbound from the city via, A563 Krefeld Way to A50 Groby Road, then A50 Groby Road to A46 and A46 back to the A5630 Junction.

Anstey Lane, Gorse Hill to Bennion Road, from 23rd February to 26th February – Diversion route inbound to the city via, A46 to A50 Groby Road, A50 Groby Road to A563 Krefeld Way, A563 Krefeld Way to A5630 Anstey Lane.

Bennion Road, Anstey Lane to Boston Road, from 23rd February to 26th February – Diversion route take Orwell Drive to Krefeld Way and follow diversion for Anstey Lane.
